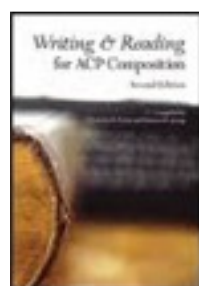


# Hello Ladies and Gentlemen!

Please make sure you pay careful attention to the titles, authors, and edition numbers. Old editions will come up on an Amazon search and will be temptingly cheap, but then you'll have the wrong book and will have to spend more money in addition to waiting on a new one to arrive.

## FOR THE FALL SEMESTER, YOU WILL NEED TWO BOOKS:

❖ ***Writing Analytically (Seventh Edition)* by David Rosenwasser and Jill Stephen-** please purchase this far in advance; you have a summer reading assignment from it. Both used and new copies are available from the IU book store, or you may find it on Amazon. I would recommend purchasing this book rather than renting it, as you will want to have it for both semesters and will be able to use it as a reference book throughout your college career.



❖ ***Writing & Reading for ACP Composition (Second Edition)* edited by Christine R. Farris and Deanna M. Jessup** - you will need this within the first week of school, so don't delay purchasing it. You might find used versions of this, but most likely you'll either need to buy a copy from someone currently in the class or purchase it through IU's bookstore.

## FOR THE SPRING SEMESTER, YOU WILL NEED ONE ANTHOLOGY AND ONE NOVEL:

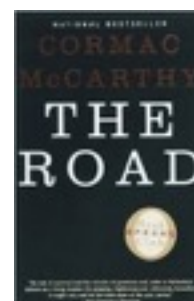
❖ ***Making Literature Matter (fifth edition)* edited by John Schilb and John Clifford** - please make sure you have this text; while some stories and texts may be available online, there are additional materials in the anthology that you will need.



❖ Your summer reading novel selection (*The Road* by Cormac McCarthy or *American Gods* by Neil Gaiman)

## INSTRUCTIONS FOR ORDERING THROUGH IU'S ONLINE BOOKSTORE:

1. Go to <http://tisbookiu.com/home.aspx>
2. Go to TEXTBOOKS at the top of the page, and select Buy/Rent Textbooks
3. You will see three boxes.
  - A. In the first box (Term), select FALL 16 (or SPRING 17 for second semester).
  - B. In the second box (Department), select ENG-W (or ENG-L for the spring).
  - C. In the third box (Course and Section), scroll until you find the course number (131 or 202), Central Catholic, and Shuey.
  - D. Once you've selected all three, click ADD SELECTION at the right, then click the GET COURSE MATERIAL button below the boxes.
4. You should arrive at a page that displays the two texts you need and gives you options for purchasing or renting the books. From there, the rest of the process should be straightforward.
