The philosophy of the required uniform is to instill a sense of pride and belonging at Central Catholic Junior-Senior High School. Because our uniform has played such an important role in Catholic education, all students should wear their uniform with a sense of pride. In addition to a sense of unity, uniforms will reduce the materialistic distractions and help to focus our students on their education. In conformity to the dress code and Christian modesty, students are required to properly wear the uniform from the moment they enter school until they leave school. This includes wearing pants and skirts at their proper height, keeping all appropriate buttons fastened, ties appropriately tied, and all other uniform requirements.

JUNIOR AND SENIOR HIGH BOYS

Dress Uniform (All School Mass Day and as required)

1. Elderwear poly-cotton navy pleated or flat front dress pants (no "Cargo" type) with CC logo on left hip
2. Elderwear White button-down collar oxford long or short sleeved shirt with crest, tucked in at all times
3. Corsair navy and white striped tie

Daily Uniform

1. Elderwear navy or khaki shorts with CC logo on left hip may be worn only during August/September and May/June (no "Cargo" type)
2. Elderwear poly-cotton navy or khaki pleated or flat front dress pants with CC logo on left hip (no "Cargo" type)
3. White or navy turtleneck, tucked in at all times
4. Elderwear white or navy knit placket polo shirt with either long or short sleeves, tucked in at all times

Everyday Appearance Expectations

1. Solid navy or gray sweaters, sweatshirts, and team issued jackets with the LCSS crest or CC logo in the right or left front corner may be worn with the dress or daily uniform and must be worn with the appropriate shirt and tie if required. Hoodies are not permitted. Sweaters must be purchased through Risse Brothers. The navy crew, v-neck pullover, or crew neck cardigan must have the LCSS crest. The navy CC fleece pullover may be purchased from the CC main office. CC athletic team issued jackets must be navy or gray with only the CC logo or LCSS crest. No other writing or uniform numbers can be visible.
2. Shoes: Shoes must have a covered toe, covered heel, and hard sole for safety purposes. Shoes must be solid in color or contain a combination of the following colors: navy, black, white, brown, tan, and/or gray. No other colors are permitted on shoes. House slippers, moccasins, sandals, and flip flops are not permitted. Solid colored shoe laces must be navy, black, white, brown, tan, or gray.
3. Socks should be worn with shoes.
4. Undershirts must be all white and without printing. Long sleeve undershirts may not be worn under short sleeve uniform shirts.
5. Plain black, navy, brown, or white belts are required with all clothing having belt loops. Belt buckles must be simple and original to the belt.
6. No exposed body piercings or tattoos. Gauges are not permitted.
7. Hair must be clean and well groomed. Visible hair color should be of natural tones. Bangs will be no longer than touching the eyebrows. Hair length is not to exceed the top of the back collar and mid-ear.
8. Face must be clean-shaven. Side-burns may be no longer than even with the bottom of the ear-lobe and neatly trimmed. No beards or goatees. A medical excuse from a board certified physician may exempt a student from shaving for a period of time.
9. Earrings, large jewelry, billfold or watch chains are not permitted.
10. All uniforms must fit the student appropriately as determined by the administration.
11. Field Trips: Uniforms are to be worn on field trips. Any exception must be requested by the teacher or sponsor and approved by the administration prior to the trip.

JUNIOR AND SENIOR HIGH GIRLS

Dress Uniform (All School Mass Day and as required)

1. Elderwear poly-cotton kick pleated skort (blue, green, yellow, white plaid). Skort length must not exceed 3 inches from the top of the kneecap to the bottom of the skort when standing. Skorts must be a modest fit, not tight fitting.
2. Elderwear white oxford blouse with button-down collar with long or short sleeves with LCSS crest, tucked in the skirt, not rolled outside.

Daily Uniform

1. Elderwear navy or khaki shorts with CC logo on left hip may be worn only during August/September and May/June.
2. Elderwear poly-cotton navy or khaki flat front dress pants with CC logo on left hip or Elderwear poly-cotton kick pleated skort (blue, green, yellow, white plaid). Skort length must not exceed 3 inches from the top of the kneecap to the bottom of the skort when standing. Skorts must be a modest fit, not tight fitting.
3. Elderwear white or navy knit placket polo shirt with either long or short sleeves or white or navy turtleneck tucked in at all times.

Everyday Appearance Expectations

1. Solid navy or gray sweaters, sweatshirts, and team issued jackets with the LCSS crest or CC logo in the right or left front corner may be worn with the dress or daily uniform and must be worn with the appropriate shirt. Hoodies are not permitted. Sweaters must be purchased through Risse Brothers. The navy crew, v-neck pullover, or crew neck cardigan must have the LCSS crest. The navy CC fleece pullover may be purchased from the CC main office. CC athletic team issued jackets must be navy or gray with only the CC logo or LCSS crest. No other writing or uniform numbers can be visible.
2. Shoes: Shoes must have a covered toe, covered heel, and hard sole for safety purposes. Shoes must be solid in color or contain a combination of the following colors: navy, black, white, brown, tan, and/or gray. No other colors are permitted on shoes. House slippers, moccasins, sandals, and flip flops are not permitted. Solid colored shoe laces must be navy, black, white, brown, tan, or gray.
3. Socks should be worn with shoes but are not to be worn above the knee. Leggings and tights are to be navy, black, or gray, and solid in color, pattern, and design.
4. Plain black, navy, brown, or white belts are required with all clothing having belt loops. Belt buckles must be simple and original to the belt.
5. No exposed body piercings or tattoos. Gauges are not permitted.
6. Hair must be clean and well groomed. Visible hair color should be of natural tones. Hair accessories should be simple and coordinate with the uniform.
7. Make-up: Lip gloss, blush, and eye make-up is permitted in moderation for female students.
8. All uniforms must fit the student appropriately as determined by the administration.
9. Field Trips: Students are expected to wear the daily school uniform on field trips. Any exception must be requested by the teacher or sponsor and approved by the administration prior to the trip.

Consequences for Dress Code Violations

A dress code violation is a Level 1 offense and is subject to the sanctions pertaining to such an offense. However, a dress code violation will not count in the cumulative discipline progression but instead will result in the student losing his or her future Spirit Day privileges. On the third violation and beyond, the student will lose his or her Spirit Day privileges for the remainder of the semester and be assigned a detention for each offense. Should a student be in violation of the dress code, the student's parent or guardian may be called and required to bring in proper dress. In some circumstances, students may be sent home for inappropriate dress. Such absences will be reported as unexcused. In rare instances and with prior approval, a student may be issued an "Out of Dress Code" pass by the Principal.

Clothing for P.E.

1. Only non-uniform navy shorts are permitted
2. Uniform T-shirt purchased at "The Athlete"
3. Street shoes are NOT acceptable for P.E. classes

Spirit Day Dress Code

1. The Principal and members of the Principal's Administrative Team will choose a SPIRIT DAY, at their discretion, and the uniform dress code will be waived in accordance with the following guidelines. Additional SPIRIT DAYS may include Spirit Week, Birthdays, Battle of the Classes Champion, Senior Days and Special Team Recognition.
2. Jeans, jean shorts, casual slacks or walking shorts will be allowed and must be clean, neat, without holes or tears, and must be hemmed. The shorts' length must be determined by the administration. No bib overalls are permitted. Gym shorts, boxer shorts, PJ pants, sweats, warm-ups, short-shorts, and/or spandex shorts are not allowed. Exceptions may be designated by the administration. (Monthly birthday recognition is a jeans day)
3. Any shirt worn on a Spirit Day must bear the school name or logo. If a student does not own a school shirt, any CC school uniform shirt is acceptable. Tank tops, halter-tops, spandex tops, and shirts with cut-off sleeves are not acceptable. (These are for sports and extra-curricular group recognition)
