

Central Catholic Semi-formal Dress Code

Frostbite Winter Dance - Saturday, January 26, 2019

The Lafayette Catholic School System, centered on Jesus Christ, educates the whole person in a culture that is: sustained by Gospel witness and service; imbued with a Catholic worldview; supported by a community of faith; distinguished by academic excellence; and committed to student success.

Note: Diocesan Policy D2000 states the following: While it is the primary responsibility of parents to oversee the appropriateness of dress for school functions, it is the responsibility of the school to establish acceptable guidelines for parents to follow. Dress codes for students should emphasize modesty and neatness in appearance.

According to the Knightline - Dress Code for Semi-formal Dance - Women:


- Christian modesty
- Hemlines should be at least 1" below fingertips while standing with relaxed shoulders.
- Spaghetti straps and strapless dresses are allowed - as long as they provide modest coverage in both front and back (use 4" above the waist as a guideline for the back of the dress).
- Dresses should not reveal cleavage - (use the width of the girl's hand from the pit of the neck as a guideline).
- No bare midriff
- Dress must be a modest fit, not tight fitting - (dresses are too tight if they reveal the seams of undergarments or are riding up while walking or dancing).
- Tights/leggings may only be worn with a dress/skirt that fits the guidelines listed above

This Dress Code must be followed. Girls (CC students and guests) arriving in dresses that follow the rules stated above will be allowed to participate in the dance.
